In 2008 the thaw was 1/6-1/13. It was 1/1-1/16 in 2007. It was 1/8-1/14 and 1/18-21 in 2006. It was 1/13-1/14/05, 1/8-1/10/03, 1/10-1/18/02 and 1/22-1/31/02, 1/14-1/17/01, and 1/1-1/12/00. January 13 is traditionally the coldest day of the year.
