<p>The average yearly snowfall at Bradley is 47". Mansfield Hollow Dam averages 44". Winter '95/'96 gave Bradley an all time record of 115.2" (breaking '93/'94 mark of 84.9"). Lebanon had 106.5". Winter '94/'95 saw just 22.3" at Bradley. Bradley got 47.5" in '07/'08, just 24.0" in winter '06/'07, 69.9" in '05/'06, 74.1" in '04/'05, 45.5" in '03/'04, and 61" in '02/'03. Mansfield Hollow Dam had only 16" in '01/'02, 71.5" in '00/'01, 20.3" in '99/'00, and 33" in '98/'99.</p> <p>The average temperature for the first three months of 1994 was 26.0° at Bradley – the coldest start to a year on record. February 1998 tied 1954 as the warmest February on record (+8.7°). Storrs had 97 consecutive days with snow cover in winter '00/'01 – the most in the prior 30 years.
